This 44th annual event is staged by the North Hampshire Austin Enthusiasts Group (NHAEG) on behalf of the Austin Ten Drivers' Club with categories for pre-war vintage, post-war classic (up to 1978) and modern (post 1978) cars of all makes.



The event is unique, as it takes place during the hours of darkness. The entrants venture from Old Basing into the Hampshire/ Berkshire/ Surrey countryside to a number of Manned & Unmanned Control points.



At Manned Controls, the teams perform a simple orienteering exercise shown on their task sheet to find the name of a bird, hidden somewhere in each location.

Then, back in Old Basing, prizes are presented to the class winners, after a fish & chip supper.
