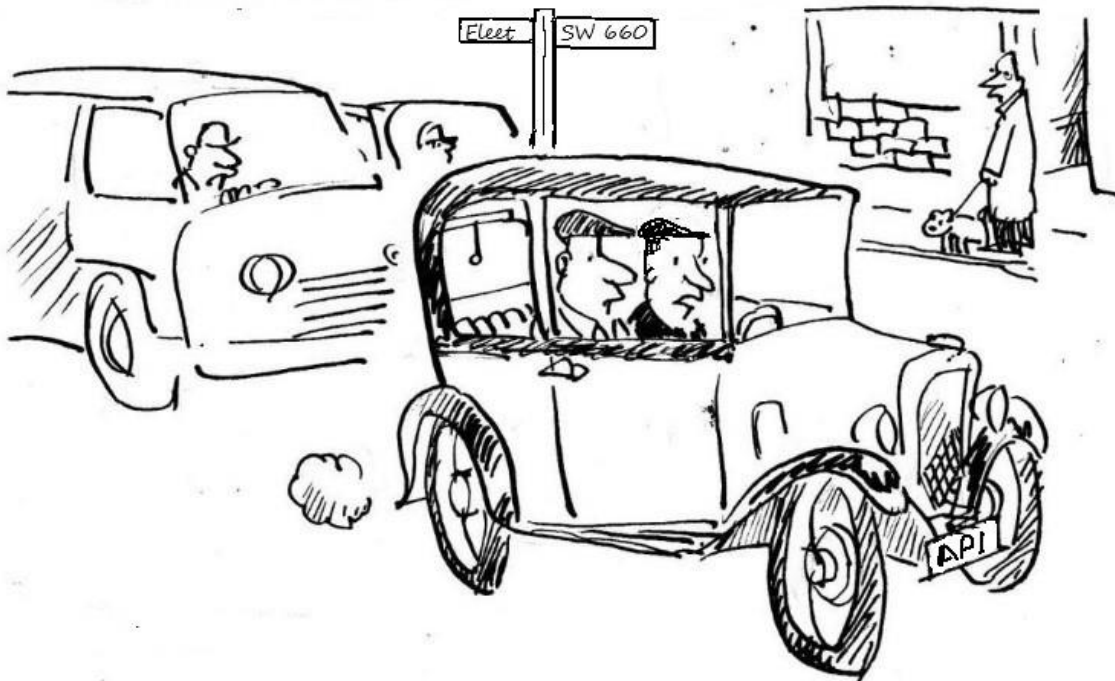


SOUTH WEST 660 EXPERIENCE THE JOURNEY DISCOVER THE DESTINATION
